We're seeking individuals or organizations whose dedication and achievements have promoted a safer environment. Nominees' accomplishments should be explained *using where applicable the suggested descriptions below*, and may be in one or more of the listed categories. Just check the box or boxes that apply, and use the next sheet to briefly explain the factors involved.

**#1. Act of heroism:**

What happened, where, how many people were involved, what did the nominee do that was heroic, and of course the outcome of the act of heroism for the hero and others.

**#2. Development of an innovative safety program:**

How many employees were affected, how long did it take to develop and put in place, when did it actually go into effect, how is the program different or unique from what has been done up to now, what have been the results in - occurrences - frequency - dollars - hours - manpower - or other measures, and between what dates have these results been measured?

**#3. Efforts that resulted in dramatically reduced numbers of injuries & accidents:**

Use the same types of explanations and measures as in #2 above.

**#4. Development of safety programs resulting in direct time and cost savings:**

In addition to same types of explanations and measures as in #2 above, be sure to give comparisons from prior years or similar projects.

**#5. Individuals or organizations with long time impeccable safety records:**

Use the same types of explanations and measures as in #4 above.

**#6. Other dedication or achievements showing they "went the extra mile":**

Use the same types of explanations and measures as in #4 above which are appropriate to the situation.

In all instances be sure to include a description of the company it's type(s) of activity, its geographic area covered, total number of employees, number of sites if there are branches, how long the company has been in business, and the company's annual gross revenue. The judges need to get a full idea of the nominee's setting.
