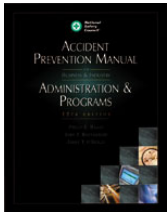

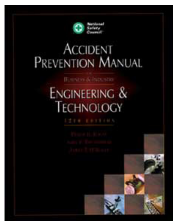

This is the first volume in the two-volume standard reference for safety and health professionals. The APR includes chapters on indoor air quality, workplace violence, safety culture, and the safety professional.



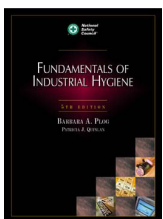
Accident Prevention Manual (12th Ed.), Engineering & Technology, \$109.95

This book expands on volume one by covering safety practices from many facets of production operations and exposures. The APM includes chapters on designing in safety and occupational medical surveillance.



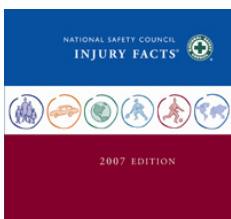
Supervisor's Safety Manual (9th Ed.), \$87.95
