Teens can experience the use of our “**FOCUS SIMULATOR**”, an effective method of building confidence in new drivers and giving them realistic “behind the wheel” practice in defensive

driving skills. A study released by the Center for Disease Control shows that driving simulation training can reduce car crashes among novice drivers by as much as 65%.

Try on a pair of “Fatal Vision Goggles” for a better understanding of how being impaired contributes to automobile collisions. Watch a breathalyzer demonstration. For our seniors, there will be a “Car Fit” display to help you understand the importance of properly adjusting the steering wheel, seat, and mirrors to fit you before driving a vehicle. Interested in learning to ride a motorcycle? Safety Center Incorporated offers both the basic rider’s course and the experienced rider’s course.

Safety Center Incorporated offers occupational safety training! If it’s safety, we train it. Would you like to learn CPR? “Air Safetybill”, the CPR manikin, will be available for demonstrations. Have you ever seen a remote controlled forklift? Our senior staff instructor will be on hand to give you some safety tips on proper use of mobile equipment. What does it feel like to wear a fall protection body harness? Come try one on!

Looking for entertainment? We’ll have that, too! There will be an ongoing program on the patio of the training building that will include Trevor the Magician. There will also be a chance

FIRST 72 HOURS

It’s not a question of “if” a disaster will strike, it’s when. Are you prepared?
